

Imagine you have arrived at this PDF because you have an interview coming up for a Band 5 Nurse post. You are probably wondering what interview questions they will ask.

Having completed the relevant Nursing qualifications and registered with the NMC you can now apply for nursing posts at Band 5. These are usually within one of four areas: adult nursing, child nursing, mental health or learning disabilities and of course within these areas there are a range of specialties.

What Your Band 5 Interview Questions Focus on:

For all Band 5 posts, you will be required to take part in a formal interview.

Once you have passed the initial shortlisting, you should receive an update and an invitation to interview. You will take part in a formal interview, which may take place the same day or at a later date agreed by you.

Your interview will most likely be in front of a panel, with a minimum of 2 people and you should **expect a blended interview with a combination of questions including competency based**. Be prepared with examples showing compassion, professionalism and safe, evidence-based practice in patient care.

- Previous experience, skills, training and motivation
- How you deliver Safe and Compassionate Patient Care
- Clinical Questions and Assessments and Observations
- Communicate Effectively with Patients and Teams
- How you manage Your Workload with Supervision
- Your ability to engage in Continuous Learning and Reflection
- Knowledge of NHS topics and issues

Top 12 Band 5 Nurse Interview Questions

5. What skills do you use when you have an exceptionally busy ward. Give us a recent example.
6. Can you briefly talk me through your understanding of Safeguarding in a Nursing environment.
7. Describe a time when you felt you gave optimum care to your patient. What did you do that made the experience so good for your patient?
8. You have made a mistake when treating a patient. What do you do?
9. What do you know about the sepsis six bundle? Talk us through a recent example of when you cared for a patient with sepsis.
10. What guidelines and procedures would you follow regarding urinary catheter maintenance in order to prevent urinary tract infection (UTI)?
11. How would you recognise and respond to a patient showing signs of sepsis?
12. A patient's condition deteriorates suddenly—what immediate actions would you take?
